In this episode of Making the Links Radio, we interview David Hugill, a PhD student in Human Geography at York University, about his recently released book, *Missing Women, Missing News: Covering Crisis in Vancouver's Downtown Eastside*. In *Missing Women, Missing News*, David Hugill examines newspaper coverage of the arrest and trial of Robert Pickton, the man charged with murdering 26 street-level sex workers from Vancouver's Downtown Eastside. He argues that the coverage offers a series of coherent explanations that hold particular individuals and practices accountable but largely omit, conceal, or erase the broader social and political context that renders those practices possible.
